A product of both Florida and Georgia, Collins received his law degree from Boston College Law School and an MBA from Florida A&M University where he was elected Student Body President and served as a member of the University's Board of Trustees. He is Treasurer of the Washington Bar Association and a member of the Illinois State Bar and the D.C. Bar.
